What to Expect

Project activities include open trench construction, excavation, installation of flow meter vault and conduit, backfill work, and supply and equipment deliveries.

- Closure of boundary trail from Navajo Place to Via Las Vegas during construction hours, from July 22 - August 2
- Parking restrictions on north end of Via Las Vegas during construction work hours, from July 17 – August 2; "No Parking" signs posted in advance
- Some noise, dust and vibration during construction activities
- Through-traffic on Via Las Vegas will be maintained at all times
- Access to driveways on Via Las Vegas maintained at all times
- No disruption to utility, trash or delivery services

Location



The boundary trail from Navajo Place to Via Las Vegas will be closed during work hours. There will be parking restrictions on the north end of Via Las Vegas near the trail during construction work hours.
