Upcoming Bidding Opportunities

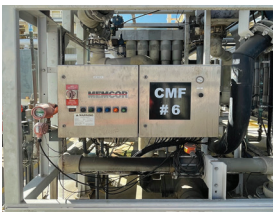
We are excited to announce several significant bidding opportunities for our vendors. These projects contribute to the enhancement of our infrastructure, ensuring the continued delivery of high-quality water to our communities.



Operations and Maintenance Services for Recycled Water Treatment Facilities

Fall 2024

West Basin initiated a competitive bidding process with a request for proposals for the operation and maintenance (O&M) of their five facilities. A service provider is projected to be operating under a new contract by summer 2025.



Distributed Control System (DCS) Replacement

Winter 2024 | Total Project Cost \$30.7M (1st Phase \$5M)

Installation of a new DCS across every West Basin facility to provide a modern control system that is cohesive across all sites and a solid platform for future site improvements. This will include upgrading and replacing all defunct and obsolete controllers to create a modern future-proof Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) system within ECLWRF.



Chevron Nitrification Treatment Plant Bulk Chemical Storage Improvements

1st Phase Sodium Chloride Tank Replacement

Winter 2024 | Total Project Cost \$2.3M (1st Phase \$300,000)

This project will replace the bulk chemical storage tanks and ancillary equipment and implement safety and compliance improvements.



Juanita Millender-McDonald Carson Regional Water Recycling Plant Bulk Chemical Storage Improvements

1st Phase NaCl Tank Replacement

Winter 2024 | Total Project Cost \$3.2M (1st Phase \$300,000)

This project will update aging chemical storage structures and appurtenances to ensure safety and reliable water production by replacing or rehabilitating tanks, pumps, and controls as necessary.
